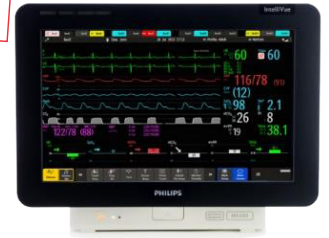

Infant Bedside Monitors

Quantity needed: ~~4~~ 1
Cost per unit: \$15,000

Critical in monitoring vitals and conducting cardiac screening tests, infant bedside monitors ensure the safety of newborn patients. There's currently only 6 monitors at Richmond Hospital, with 4 at the end of its life span. New monitors will improve timely access and safety, and ensure compatibility with the new Electronic Medical Records system at Richmond Hospital.

Quantity needed: ~~2~~ 2
Cost per unit: \$28,000

Incubators are used to regulate the temperature of newborns when ongoing thermal regulation is required. It provides a safe supported space for infants as their vital organs continue to develop. Unlike a basic bassinet, the incubator offers the flexibility to adjust various environment factors, including temperature, oxygen levels, humidity, and light, ensuring an optimal setting for newborn's well-being.



Of the current 10 incubators, 3 are out of support with no available parts, and are not compatible with the new Electronic Medical Records system. These new incubators are quieter, have the ability to monitor central and peripheral skin temperature simultaneously, and the function to maintain automated settings and silence alarms when the infant is out for cuddles.
